Re: Recount, Protest, Request

The 2011 California Elections Code #15620, in the third paragraph states as follows:

For the purposes of this section, "completion of the canvass" shall be presumed to be that time when the elections official signs the certified statement of the results of the elections except that, **in the case of a city election, if a city council canvasses the returns itself and does not order the elections official to conduct the canvass * * *, "completion of the canvass" shall be presumed to be that time when the governing body declares the persons elected or the measures approved or defeated.**

I believe "elections officials" means the Los Angeles County Registrar not the Burbank City Clerk. And "a city council canvasses the returns itself" means that the City Clerk of the City of Burbank conducts the canvass.

The Burbank City Council declared the results of the April 12, 2011 election certified on April 26, 2011 in Item 7, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS HELD ON APRIL 12, 2011, therefore, and the five days to request a recount, "Protest," began on April 27.
